

## Step three:


Go back into [Oxford Owl](#).

Scroll Down and Open this by clicking on Play




Select widescreen if your are casting.




When your students click on the link they will see this screen:

Students click on 'login' and enter your class username and password:





It will take them to this screen:




# Step five:
